Roy Christman thanked Guy Seifert for using his equipment and closing up the windows on the Greensweik School.

Mr. Christman addressed the issue of the Koch Bridge, stating that it could not be saved, but the Historical commission is righting a letter to the Carbon County Commissioners asking for certain conditions to be placed on the construction of the new bridge as well as the remover of a plague from the old bridge and its placement on the new bridge.
