Construction Work Certification:

I hereby certify that:

(1) the work associated with this project will be completed in accordance with the provided supporting documents/plans and shall be done in full compliance with the applicable ordinances of the Township and/or Codes adopted by the Township.

(5) any error, misstatement, or misrepresentation of material fact in this Application, or any change in location, size or use of structure or land made subsequent to the issuance of this Permit, without approval of the Township Building Code Official, Construction Code Official,

Zoning Officer, Engineer, Roadmaster, or any other Authorized Representative of the Township, shall constitute sufficient grounds for the revocation of this Permit.

I further state that:

(6) I will notify the Township Building Code Official, Construction Code Official, Zoning Officer, Engineer, Roadmaster, or any other Authorized Representative of the Township prior to the start of construction to determine a schedule of required site inspections.

(7) I will notify the Township Building Code Official, Construction Code Official, Zoning Officer, Engineer, Roadmaster, or any other Authorized Representative of the Township upon completion of the site improvements to request a final inspection.

(8) I understand that there is a deadline to have the final inspection performed and, once that deadline passes, I will be required to pay an additional fee to extend the deadline date another year, or I can cancel the permit without reimbursement.
