Karl Rolappe brought up a dangerous road condition in the area of Stagecoach Road West and Bartholomew Drive. The shoulders of the road are heavily wooded on both sides and need to be cleared. He had an unsafe encounter sharing the road with a tractor trailer.

Supervisor Seifert told Greg Haas to look into the matter as other errors have been found on the 2015 Map. He told the Deckers that the Township would be in contact with them in the future.
