She was uncertain what other options there are and stated she knows half the residents cooperate and half do not. Supervisor John Kleintop proceeded to explain that a portion of the road is a safety issue for the township's garbage trucks to enter. He stated he was informed by the Roadmaster, Scott Mosier that the road is only plowed on the blacktop portion and there are overgrown trees/brush starting at the dirt road section. Scott Mosier suggested having a dumpster placed or placing modified stone on the dirt road section as temporary fix with it being winter. Barbara stressed her concern on not knowing what to do with her garbage until the residents of Kennetta Lane can come to an agreement on improving the road conditions. John went over the township's garbage ordinance and suggested placing modified stone as well.

Roy Christman from Pohopoco Drive entered the conversation, stating he noticed Twinflower Circle has dumpsters at the end of their private road due the same situation.
